The course input includes:

- Overview of current fire safety legislation.
- An introduction to fire - and how fast moving and devastating it can be.
- The chemistry of fire - including the elements of combustion in the 'fire triangle,' types of fuels, products of combustion, and how fire spreads.
- Fire phenomenon – backdraft, flashover, fire gas explosion.
- Classification of fire - how the types of fires are classified; the importance when selecting an extinguisher; assessment of size of fire which staff should handle with equipment provided; location and, when appropriate, the use of firefighting equipment.
- Isolating power supplies to machines and processes.
- Practical firefighting safety rules.
- Information firefighters need to help them tackle a fire effectively when they arrive.
- Fire safety on site.
- Types of fire protection, systems, and signage.
- We review the specific risks in a workplace, including high-risk areas and how housekeeping and vigilance can help stop fires from happening.
- Fire Warden responsibilities.
- We will review the duties of a Fire Warden and look at how people's actions during a real fire can create significant risks and hamper an evacuation.
